

Designer's Choice Necklace: Photoshop File Directions

1. Choose the metal color for your necklace – either GOLD, RHODIUM or GUNMETAL
2. Open the Photoshop file that is titled with your metal selection.
3. The file is organized in individual layers including the following:
 - a. color palette representing 16 different gemstones (reference stone chart in following page)
 - b. 9 stone shapes
 1. organic nugget
 2. ellipse
 3. oval
 4. rounded square
 5. small teardrop
 6. pie
 7. marquis
 8. circle
 9. tiny teardrop
 - c. 3 types of chain
 1. thick textured link
 2. medium textured link
 3. fine rope
4. Use the layers to design your necklace. Duplicate, rotate and arrange the layers as you desire, but DO NOT manipulate their size (each layer is in correct proportion). You may replicate whole chains or select pieces of the chains to create layers of swag for your necklace.
5. Using the given palette of 16 colors, utilize the magic wand, eyedropper and paint bucket tools to color in the stone shapes to bring your custom necklace to life.
6. If necessary, you may change the canvas size of the file to accommodate a larger design.
7. Once you have completed your necklace, output it as a PDF, JPG or PNG format before uploading the final design to the website.
